



Commodore Dan MacKeigan is the senior Outreach Flag Officer on behalf of the Commander of the Royal Canadian Navy (RCN). In his 41st year of service, he remains an active duty member of the Royal Canadian Navy and the extended Naval Board. His most recent Naval appointments are Director NATO Maritime Planning at Northwood UK (2012-2015), preceded by being Commander of the Canadian Forces Recruiting Group (CFRG), where he was responsible for joint Army, Navy and Air Force recruiting across Canada (2009-2012). His Sea Commands include HMCS IROQUOIS, a Command and Control and long range air defence configured destroyer, wherein he deployed as flagship for Standing NATO Maritime Group One in Operation ACTIVE ENDEAVOUR, NATO's Counter Terrorism Mission. Previously, he commanded the frigate HMCS CALGARY as Commander Task Force APOLLO, Canada's maritime counter terrorism operation in the Persian Gulf area. Staff appointments include Chief of Staff (Support), Canadian Expeditionary Forces Command Headquarters (Joint operations Command) and commander of the Canadian Forces Maritime Warfare Centre in Halifax.

There, he was the Maritime Warfare Authority responsible for developing new doctrine and tactics for the Fleet. This was preceded by earlier positions in tactical development and instruction at the Warfare Centre, and at the Royal Navy School of Maritime Operations. He was Director of the NORAD/US Space Command Cheyenne Mountain Command Centre a during the dynamic 1999-2002 period.
